Product description

Solvent-free, odourless, high-quality dispersion adhesive. Quick adhesion and long adhesive effect. Only indoors for adhesion of elastic and textile floor coverings, like PVC and CV coverings in membranes and tiles, PVC foam coverings and flexible tiles, as well as textile coverings with Latex, PVC and PU foam backs. Especially suited for the adhesion of elastic coverings on non-absorbent substrates. Suitable for underfloor heating systems and for castor wheel loads.

Processing

The adhesive is to be applied to the whole surface of the substrate with a suitable notched trowel. The trowel toothing depends on the covering type and the backing of the covering. Allow the adhesive to ventilate according to the amount applied, the substrate absorbency and the room climate, then lay the covering and rub in well. Rub in the seams and head ends again after a short time. The covering must be laid without tension and it must be level.

Usage as wet bed adhesive: lay on well-absorbent substrate surface tiles immediately, on covering membranes after a flash-off time of 10 to 20 minutes. Usage as adhesive bed adhesive: Allow to ventilate 30 to 40 minutes on poor to non-absorbent substrates, depending on the room climate, or until the adhesive starts to become transparent.

Milling and welding of the seams can take place at the earliest after 24 hours, afterwards they are to be well smoothed in again. Roller castor load at the earliest after 72 hours.

- Colour consistency can only be guaranteed within a batch.
- The colouring is significantly influenced by the environmental conditions.

Environmental advice:

- Do not process at temperatures below +15 °C!
- The ideal temperature range for material, substrate, and air is +15 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ to +25 $^{\circ}\text{C}$.
- The ideal air humidity range is between 40% to 60%.
- Increased humidity and/or lower temperatures delay, lower air humidity and/or higher temperatures accelerate drying, setting, and hardening.
- Ensure sufficient ventilation during the drying, reaction, and hardening phase; avoid draughts!
- Protect from direct sunlight, wind, and weather!
- Protect adjacent components!

Tips:

- We recommend using a test surface first or a small area for initial, small-scale testing.
- Observe the product data sheets of all MUREXIN products used in the system.
- Keep a genuine original container of the respective batch for later repair work.
