

Processing

The adhesive is to be applied to the whole surface of the substrate with a suitable notched trowel. The trowel toothing depends on the covering type and the backing of the covering. Lay the covering to be laid immediately into the wet adhesive bed without flash-off time and rub in completely. Problematic areas like sloping inlets, head ends, seams etc. must be rubbed in again after a short time. Milling and welding of the seams can take place at the earliest after 24 hours. Afterwards, they are to be well smoothed in again. Roller castor load at the earliest after 72 hours.

Linoleum and cork linoleum: toothing B1 or B2 Textile coverings with smooth rear: toothing A2

Textile coverings with embossed or latex rear: toothing A2 or B1

Textile coverings with jute and synthetic second backing, needle felt and woven goods: toothing B1

- Ensure sufficient ventilation during the drying, reaction, and hardening phase; avoid draughts!
- Protect from direct sunlight, wind, and weather!
- Protect adjacent components!
